You can join us at Nalanda or online for the next module of Exploring Buddhism starting on **Thursday**, **16 January at 7.30pm**. The 3-month module will be led by **Geshe Losel** who will be teaching at Nalanda Monastery from 16 January for the first 6 weeks. After that, Geshe-la will be teaching **online** only.

- Understanding the three-fold structure of a classic text (refuting others' systems, presenting the author's own system and eliminating disputes)
 - Learning how to debate
- Introducing the basic Buddhist concepts drawn from Collected Topics
 - Introduction to Signs and Reasoning (Tarig)
- Understanding the progression from a wrong view, through the three types of doubt, to correct assumption and finally valid inference.




FPMT Exploring Buddhism


