

Lhabab Duchen - 11 November 2025

Lhabab Duchen is celebrated on the 22nd day of the ninth lunar month. This year it falls on 11 November 2025.

We celebrate Buddha Shakyamuni's return to Earth from the realm of the Thirty-Three Devas on this day, after he had taught the Dharma to his mother, Mayadevi, and the other Devas.

It is said that the effects of karmic deeds are multiplied 300 million times on these special days.



One way in which Lama Zopa Rinpoche advises us to increase our meritorious karma is to take or renew the eight Mahayana vows. Thanks to Kopan

Monastery, students can receive these vows directly from Lama Zopa Rinpoche.

To celebrate Lhabab Duchen, we will perform a **Guru Puja at 19:00** in the main gompa. It is open to everyone!



Principal Teacher, H.H. the 6th Kyabje
Yongzin Ling Rinpoche, who passed
away in 1983.

AN EXCEPTIONNAL WEEKEND WITH DR LOBSANG

29-30 November 2025



On 29 and 30th November 2025, Tibetan Doctor Lobsang will give an intensive teaching on how to face challenges and help the unavoidable two truths, sickness and death, that all human beings will experience in life according to **Traditional Tibetan Medicine and Psychology**.

Saturday 29 November: First truth, diseases and illnesses

9.30 to 12.30 and 14.30 to 18.30

The teaching will share profound information on various causes of particular acute diseases like cancers, brain stroke, chronic diseases, blood pressure, heart attack and so on that provoke premature death. We will explore how to help prevent such diseases based on proper psychology, diet, correct disciplines and behaviours etc. in regular life.

Dimanche 30 november: Second truth, dying and death

9.30 to 12.30 and 14.30 to 18.00

Everyone born on Earth will die sooner or later. This teaching will share important knowledge on how to accept this reality, and how to prepare for it, since the time of death is uncertain:

- (a) Brief information on the conception of human physiology and the relationship between body, mind and life.
- (b) The process of dying involves the dissolution of physical energies, the five elements, the five senses and the supreme subtle wind energy into mental

consciousness, which will travel to the next life through the Bardo (the intermediate state) and final death.

- (c) The importance of supporting dying people to help them die in harmony and peace.
- (d) A brief meditation on the experience of death with simple guidance concludes the teaching.
- (e) How to enjoy and rejoice in the present life, and how to utilise the precious gift of life to make it more beneficial and meaningful. May all sentient beings be freed from limitless suffering.


Come and study the Middle Way with us!

Online, every Thursday from 7pm to 9pm




